Some examples of the types of decisions federal policymakers may influence: funding and rules for IDEA (special education); Social Security Administration and income limits; the Americans with Disabilities Act; Medicaid funding to states; funding for Home and Community Based services and institutions; funding and rules for vocational rehabilitation (VR).
